Universiti Poly-Tech Malaysia (UPTM) successfully organized the University Social Responsibility (USR) programme titled UPTM Ecoheritage: Where Culture Meets Nature on 6 -7 September 2025 in Kuala Selangor and Kampung Sungai Haji Dorani.

The programme brought together participation from UPTM alumni, international students, and local students, along with the programme committee, who collectively carried out various activities such as mangrove tree planting, kite flying, traditional fish catching (mengagau ikan), Paloh river bathing, an international cultural night featuring the traditional kuda kepang dance performance, and a visit to a small and medium industry (SME) factory.

The success of this programme was further strengthened through strategic collaboration with Jabatan Belia dan Sukan Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur and Rakan Bumi: Friends of Lestari Alam (Series 2), with strong support from the Jabatan Perhutanan Negeri Selangor.
